Your hair loss voucher

Sherwood Forest Hospitals NHS
Foundation Trust (SFHT) is committed to
providing wigs or head coverings for NHS
patients who have temporary, long-term,
or permanent hair loss due to a medical
condition or its treatment. If you are
entitled to a hair loss prescription from
SFHT you will be given a voucher to help
with the cost of purchasing a wig, head
piece or head coverings.

How do I get a voucher?

Vouchers are sent to you by email. Paper vouchers can also be requested.

If you are a Dermatology / alopecia patient your consultant will give you a hair loss prescription. Please take this to Clinic 2 reception at King's Mill Hospital, or the General Office at Newark Hospital and your voucher will be issued. You will be entitled to two vouchers per year.

If you are a SFHT cancer patient, having chemotherapy which causes hair loss, your chemotherapy/oncology nurse, or haematology nurse will ensure that you receive your hair loss voucher. They will talk to you about this during your first appointment in the chemotherapy department. You will be entitled to one voucher per year or one per new treatment.

Where can I use my hair loss voucher?

You can take your voucher to any of the NHS-approved wig suppliers listed on this fact sheet. Your voucher can be used to purchase a wig, hair piece or head coverings. If the cost of your purchase exceeds the value of your voucher, you will be asked to pay the difference directly to the wig supplier. VAT exemption will apply.

We recommend you look at a wide range of wigs and approach different suppliers. It is important you find a supplier that you feel comfortable with as the providers will be the people you contact for any aftercare. SFHT request feedback about your experience of using the NHS suppliers. Your feedback ensures you and future patients receive the best services possible.

Which wig should I choose?

There are many different types of wigs available. Real hair wigs are not generally prescribed by the NHS, are very costly, and can be difficult to style and maintain.

Recent advances in the production of synthetic fibre wigs have ensured a high quality lower cost alternative. Synthetic wigs are much easier to style and maintain.

Your wig provider will discuss fully the benefits and drawbacks of each type of wig. They will help you to choose the right wig for you.

How do I look after my wig?

Your wig supplier will talk to you about how to care for your wig and will provide full instructions. They can also recommend products to use to help you keep your wig in good condition.

What do I do with my old wig?

Wigs that you no longer require can be donated to the wig bank, who support the reuse and recycling of wigs. You can donate and send your wigs to:
