Care of your device:

- Your device should be comfortable to wear. Please contact the department as soon as possible if you have any issues regarding its use, e.g. not fitting correctly, causing skin irritation. **Do not alter/adjust the device yourself**.
- A plastic device could lose its shape if exposed to direct heat such as a radiator, an oven or direct sunlight in summer.
- Use mild, soapy water (never hot) if needed to clean the device.
- Material items can be washed in mild, soapy water.
- Wash commercial devices as instructed on the label.
- Please being the device with you to every follow up appointment.
