Executive Summary				
<p>Safety Action 1 of the NHSR Year 3 standards requires submission of a quarterly report which demonstrates that multidisciplinary reviews have taken place for 95% of baby deaths which qualify for reporting against the Perinatal Mortality Review Tool (PMRT); and that the deaths have been reported to the PMRT within an agreed timescale.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quarter 1 is from 20 December 2019 to 31 March 2020. • There were four qualifying cases during this period – all of them have been reported to the PMRT. • There are no published reviews available as postmortem and placental histology reporting takes 4-6 months (see below). Our internal review demonstrates no care or service delivery problems. • We are therefore compliant for Quarter 1 against this aspect of NHSR Yr 3 Safety Standard 1
