

				We cannot say if the drug in question was used to treat a specific diagnosis; only a clinical review will confirm that. My extract only indicates that the drug was issued to the patient and the patient was discharged from an inpatient spell with the requisite diagnosis codes within the requested time period. A patient could have been issued more than one specified drug
Ustekinumab Biosimilar Vedolizumab				and more than one issue of the same drug in the time period requested.
