
Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 2000 - Request for Information Reference: Temporary Staffing

Yes	Section 40(2)	Names, job titles and email addresses (other than that of our board of directors) constitute personal data. Section 40(2) provides that personal data is exempt information if one of the conditions set out in section 40(3) is satisfied. In our view, disclosure of this information would breach the data protection principles contained in the General Data Protection Regulations and Data Protection Act 2018 In reaching this decision, we have particularly considered: The reasonable expectations of the employees given their positions; Sherwood Forest Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust considered that none of the individuals would have a reasonable expectation that their personal data would be disclosed; The consequences of disclosure; and any legitimate public interest in disclosure. Section 40(2) is an absolute exemption and therefore not subject to the public interest test
