ASK FOR NEWARK

Newark Hospital has significantly improved services over the last few years, and these services are still growing.

We aim to deliver the best possible care for our patients and our long-term vision is to increase the overall number of patients accessing services at Newark Hospital.

TRANSFORMING AND IMPROVING SERVICES

The Trust has invested around £5m since 2020. Recent developments include:

 A multi-million-pound project to create a third operating theatre and upgrade / relocate two existing treatment rooms and the medical day case room.
 The new theatre will focus on additional day case elective orthopaedic patients / procedures. There will be new lists for general surgery, breast and ophthalmics moving within the Newark theatre complex. This is expected to result in up to 2,600 more operations and procedures taking place each year at Newark.

• The creation of 80 extra car parking spaces for staff on land next to the hospital, to free up existing spaces for patients and visitors.

BENEFITS FOR PATIENTS

Newark Hospital services

DIAGNOSTICS

These include

- General x-rays for inpatients, outpatients (trauma and orthopaedics, podiatry, rheumatology, respiratory, urology), urgent care and GP referral. Appointments for GP patients are available from 8.45am to 5.15pm.
- Ultrasound is provided for obstetrics, gynaecology (pelvic scans), MSK (shoulders, feet), soft tissue (groins, abdominal wall lumps) and general ultrasound (abdominal, kidneys, testes).
- Dopplers are available for assessment of DVT via presentation at the Urgent Treatment Centre or referral to the Newark Hospital medic on-call via 01636 681 681.
- Scans available via referral are cancer staging scans, orthopaedic scans and CT colonography. CT Urograms can be directly requested.
- MRI appointments are available from 8am to 8pm on our mobile scanner. GP referrals can be made for lumbar spine and knee scans.
- Mammography is provided from our breast screening mobile unit on site. This service is provided by Nottingham University Hospitals.

ENDOSCOPY

Procedures are available for:

- Bronchoscopy Colonoscopy Cystoscopy
- Flexible Sigmoidoscopy Gastroscopy.

THERAPY SERVICES

Physiotherapists and occupational therapists provide assessment, rehabilitation and pre and post-operative treatment to inpatients. Outpatient therapy services include neurological, hand therapy, rheumatology, women's health, musculoskeletal, respiratory and cardiac rehabilitation.

INPATIENT WARDS

Sconce ward is our sub-acute medical ward.

We focus on patients who require treatment, assessment and support following an acute inpatient stay in hospital.

We can provide rehabilitation treatment in the form of physiotherapy and occupational therapy as well as dedicated nursing and medical care. We have a wardbased discharge coordinator who will arrange for discharge into the most appropriate setting.

We repatriate patients from other hospitals following their acute episode of care who can continue to be cared for nearer to where they live. Our overall aim is to prevent unnecessary delays and find solutions or answers quickly. We take pride in involving our patients and their families in decisions about their care.

CASTLE WARD

Castle is a newly established 18-bedded unit with a mixture of bay beds and cubicles, specialising in complex discharges and rehabilitation.

URGENT TREATMENT CENTRE

Newark Urgent Treatment Centre is open from 9am to 10pm (with the last patient seen at 9.30pm), seven days a week, to treat urgent but not life-threatening conditions. The purpose-built facility allows people to be treated and to return home as quickly as possible. We are proud of the service's consistently high performance in providing patients with timely access to urgent care.

ORTHOPAEDIC SURGERY
