### Matters of Concern or Key Risks Escalated for Noting / Action

- No Medical Lead for Sepsis.
- HSMR- Recognising the importance and complexity of the work being undertake, the committee raised questions regarding whether adequate resources were available to the team.
- Timely Care paper to be provided to the QC in specific relation to trends in cancers diagnosed at stages 1-4.

#### **Positive Assurances to Provide**

- Verbal update in relation to breast services with a formal paper to be presented in the coming months.
- Positive assurance gained in relation to HSMR, IPR, PSC, NMAHP and MAC papers.
- Positive assurance provided following BAF Risk Score comparisons to other Trusts.

## **Major Actions Commissioned / Work Underway**

- HSMR- An approach has been made with regional peer Trust Dudley Group NHS Foundation Trust, who appear to have been on a similar journey in relation to elevated HSMR. The Trust will benefit from shared learning and support.
